Ruby red with garnet hint

Aroma

Hints of roses, tobacco and spices

Palate

The palate offers ripe cherry and berry fruits up front, yet finishes with an earthy, savoury complexity with finely-grained tannins.

Grape variety

Nebbiolo

Area

Monferrato hills in Piemonte. South West aspects at altitudes between 250 and 400m. Limestone-clay $\ensuremath{\mathrm{s}}$

Vineyards

Piemonte low Guyot trellis. Planting density 4,000 - 4,500 vines/ha.

Food Match

Rich meat stew, pasta with fresh pesto, aubergine and smoked bacon.
